

Universidad de Salamanca will offer a specialized diploma program, CSET Spanish Review Session in Spain. This two-week session will prepare teachers and teacher candidates to take two of the three tests required for adding the Bilingual Authorization: CSET Subtests IV ("Foundations of Bilingual Education") and Subtest V ("History and Politics of the Spanish-Speaking World"). Teachers who obtain the Bilingual Authorization are endorsed to teach in California bilingual education classrooms. University professors from California and Spain will introduce and review content related to each of the two core CSET subtests.

For CSET IV "Foundations of Bilingual Education", content will include:

historical and legal foundations of U.S. bilingual education theoretical perspectives on bilingualism such as additive and subtractive views developmental acquisition of bilingualism and biliteracy research-based models of bilingual education optimal practices for language and content instruction assessment and evaluation home-school partnerships intercultural communication.

For CSET V "History and Politics of the Spanish-Speaking World," all topics are related to both Latin America and the U.S.:

geography and demographics

historical eras and their associated political, artistic, and intellectual activities language variation across and within countries immigration patterns, including those related to globalization socialization patterns historical and current issues related to indigenous populations evolution of religious and cultural traditions from countries of origin to the U.S. sociopolitical aspects of past and present governments contributions of well-known Latinos from history and popular culture intercultural interactions and diversity.
