Descripción de contenidos

This course presents a structured approach for tackling problems, opportunities and decisions that will ultimately help the student get better results—whether he/she is innovating, managing crises or planning for the future. Someone engaged in critical thinking is frequently asking questions of him/herself and of others; often those questions begin with the word "Why". One result of this regular questioning is an insistence on evidence as a way of justifying one's own beliefs and those entailed in the statements of others: "Why do I (you) believe that?" Most training is focused on the accumulation of facts and attempts to answer questions related to those facts. Those questions may be presented directly to the student in the form of an end-of-course examination or, in some more advanced courses, they may be generated by the student in the form of a "research question" the student poses as a starting point for a paper in which he/she "applies" the learning imparted in the course. In only the rarest of cases, however, does the student question the underlying assumptions and biases related to the knowledge imparted by the professor and/or texts employed in the course and seldom does the student consciously adopt a systematic problem-solving approach to dealing with the problem(s) posed. This course is designed to provide the practice necessary and its use in connection with a systematic approach to problem-solving to be subsequently employed throughout the course of study in the MA program.

Descripción de contenidos

The field of international relations was created with the idea of developing the necessary knowledge and tools to avoid war and resolve conflict. After WWII, the United Nations was created with this purpose and a myriad of scholars became focused on the study of international relations; thus, this field of study was born. The main objective of avoiding war therefore led to the study of war and conflict, which became a core part of the newly born field. This course thus war and other types of violent confrontation among states. It also studies how to avoid these conflicts and it is therefore directly related to other courses that are core to our Masters. The course includes a study of peace process as well, conflict resolution, the sovereignty of states, geopolitics, and how states build up their diplomatic networks. European states, especially, have been at the center of study of the field of international relations, from the 18th century balance of power arrangements to WWI and WWII, to these days' arrangements under the European Union. Therefore, this course mainly focuses on the different solutions that theories of international relations have offered in relation to war, conflict, and state rivalry in the European context.

Descripción de contenidos

Research Methods and Theory in Global Studies examines world systems, transnational processes, and global-local interactions from perspectives informed by a number of disciplines. This course will introduce students to current interdisciplinary theoretical approaches to global studies, as well as to the examination of the primary foci of contemporary research in relation to the rise of a complex world society. This is basically a theory course, but it will also benefit from practitioners as guest speakers. The course will assess the exceptional scientific and technological revolution that has changed both international and local actors. More transnational actors have produced a new global agenda that includes topics of increasing complexity and interdependence. The post-Cold War international system is a new _transitional scenario_ based upon a growing Knowledge Society and a different set of international institutions. It is also characterized by new patterns of negotiation, different kinds of international business practices, and areas of conflict, like the clash of nationalities, the struggle for identity, and failed states.

Descripción de contenidos

This course offers a master-level survey of recent studies and debates on the causes and implications of multiculturalism. The first section of the course will focus on the politics of multinationalism and polyethnicity in

Europe. In this section we will examine different institutional alternatives (federalism, secession, multilevel governance) for multinational societies, both at the nation-state and European level. We will also explore how the politicization of multiculturalism has transformed European party systems. We will conclude this section by focusing on normative debates on the relations between multiculturalism and democracy. The second part of the course provides an introduction to theoretical, historical and contemporary debates around race, ethnicity and migration. It will engage students with substantive topics but will also practically illustrate the inner workings of research in the field. We focus on the deep implications that the notions of race and ethnicity carry for thinking about identity, culture, and social hierarchy; but also for studying ethnic tensions, prejudice and political mobilization. Particular attention is paid to the challenges posited by global migration processes and the responses of local communities to the increasing diversification of the societies in which they are embedded.

Descripción de contenidos

The movement of people across national boundaries is the most critical factor that accounts for the increasingly multiethnic character of almost all post-industrial societies. Moreover, there are no issues of race and ethnicity that do

not stem from past or current patterns and processes of such movements. This course will examine the individual and structural dynamics of international migration. Following a theoretical analysis of the migration process, various aspects of immigrant settlement, adaptation, and absorption into receiving societies will be examined. Throughout the course, contemporary as well as historical cases will be used to illustrate theories, concepts, and patterns of global migration and settlement. The course will conclude with a consideration of potential political, economic, cultural, and demographic issues regarding future international population movements.

Descripción de contenidos

The course will cover the concepts and methodologies for exploring underlying structural causes of conflict, potential and actual pathways of escalation, and the efficacy of ameliorative institutions and processes of peacemaking. It will emphasize the significance of theory-informed models to comprehend the variety of methods through which assessment occurs. The first part of the course will introduce the concept of disaster, its typology and the disaster risk equation. Disasters will be treated in relation to armed conflicts, including the so-called complex or protracted emergencies. Response in a conflict situation considering the perspective of humanitarian action and humanitarian negotiation will be also outlined. During the sessions the relationship between armed conflicts and the International Humanitarian Law will be briefly discussed and the evolution of the main armed conflicts as well as the current situation of the main conflict scenarios worldwide will be also taken into consideration. An introduction to the main international actors involved in the humanitarian action as well as the Do no Harm approach will be outlined too. The second part of the course will bring students a broad understanding of what is conflict and how to analyse and understand conflicts as well as enabling students to discover their own personal approaches to conflict. Since conflicts fundamentally involve disagreements between people, the course will also look at the challenges which may arise between people of different cultures. Students will learn key skills for dealing effectively with conflict and, have the opportunity to undertake practical mediation exercises.

This course will provide an in-depth analysis of the international economic institutions, with particular emphasis on the World Bank (Group), the International Monetary Fund, and the World Trade Organization. The course begins with a brief analysis of the globalization process followed by an examination of the role international organizations and institutions play in economic globalization. This is followed by a concise discussion of the United Nations and its main organs, with particular emphasis on the Economic and Social Council. Next, the specialized agencies of the United Nations will be explored with special attention paid to the World Bank and the IMF. The role played by the other prominent international economic institutions will be discussed next, followed by an examination of the new and emerging international and global economic institutions. An examination of the role of the international organizations (such as the United Nations) and the supranational organizations (such as the European Union) in the economic globalization process will follow next. While discussing the United Nations, our focus will be on the economic arm of the organization--the Economic and Social Council--which is in charge of coordination with the specialized agencies of the United Nations. As stated above, the focus of the course will be on the evolution of the IMF and the World Bank, the most important international financial institutions, and their successes and failures. However, the course will also explore the other national and international economic institutions involved in the globalization process, such as the Export-Import Bank, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the Multilateral Development Banks. We will further examine the new and emerging international and global economic institutions, with special emphasis on the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank, that some refer to as China's own World Bank. The course will conclude with an appraisal of several important ideas proposed to improve the present global trade and overall economic arrangements. This will bring into the discussion the work of the World Trade Organization (WTO) which, together with the IMF and the World Bank, Zbigniew Brzezinski, President Jimmy Carter's National Security Advisor, referred to as "global cooperation institutions."

Descripción de contenidos

Civil wars and ethnic conflict belong to the hottest topics in contemporary political science. Influential studies of civil-war onset highlight causes such as poverty, weak state institutions as well as peripheral and inaccessible territory, but many topics remain quite controversial. In particular, scholars continue to debate the role of ethnicity and nationalism. This course introduces the participants to these debates. Focusing mostly on statistical studies at different levels of analysis, the course covers topics relating to political exclusion, economic inequality, trans-border ethnic kin and the duration and ending of ethno-nationalist conflicts. It will also highlight the different human rights impact of armed conflict in particularly vulnerable populations such as women and ethnic and religious minorities.

This course will address from a multidisciplinary perspective, with special attention to political and socio-legal approaches, the legal, political and social treatment of refugees, as defined by international regulations since the 1951 Refugee Convention, as well as the legal framework and asylum policies in force in the European Union. It also examines the development of refugee and asylum policy and legislation and the bureaucratic and legal obstacles that asylum seekers must overcome to be officially recognized as legitimate refugees. To this end, several case studies will be analyzed in specific national contexts, as well as in regional and international contexts, so that students will come to understand both the theory and the practical implications resulting from the application of the legal frameworks of asylum and refugee law and the different policies that derive from them.

Descripción de contenidos

This course consists of two modules, which are introduced as follows: Module: Institutions in Global Security: Adopting more of an institutional lens, this next course module further explores the 'structures' and 'agents' found at the heart of Global Security to intelligence, and their closely associated work. Both more abstract 'theoretical' and concentrated 'physical' (or 'real-world') aspects are covered, together with providing students with substantial insight into the major organisations behind Global Security to intelligence and how those function, are manifested, extending to upheld, in today's world, and so forth. The content of this course module naturally builds on the previous two modules introduced earlier in the course, notably: _Global Security - Part 1_. Topics covered include: Session 1: Alliances; Session 2: Regional Institutions; Session 3: The United Nations; Session 4: Peace Operations; Session 5: The Nuclear Disarmament and Non-Proliferation Regime; Session 6: Private Security Companies. Module: Introducing Contemporary Challenges in Global Security: This course module presents students with several insights into the many contemporary challenges that figure in Global Security to intelligence worlds. Main challenges that can be considered the most significant feature - for example, in terms of their (at least potential) impact. Some of these challenges are considered so relevant and pivotable in today's world - such as, *inter alia.*: 'Migration', 'Terrorism' to 'Counterterrorism' - that, beyond being presented here in more of merely an introductory manner, those themes are also explored in more complementary and in-depth case study detail in some of the other 'deeper-diving' course modules that also appear and already exist as part of this overall 'Global Security & Intelligence' masters programme track (as detailed separately and individually elsewhere in this document). Topics covered include: Session 1: Genocide and Crimes Against Humanity & Ethnic Conflict; Session 2: Migration and Refugees, Women, Peace and Security & Health; Session 3: Energy Security & Environmental Change; Session 4: Terrorism & Counterterrorism & Counterinsurgency; Session 5: Transnational Organized Crime & International Arms Trade; Session 6: Cyber Security & Outer Space.

Descripción de contenidos

The first part of the course will provide students an understanding of the different stages of clinical development as well as the regulatory process of Investigational New Drug Application (IND) and New Drug Application (NDA). Further, the course will explain basic concepts of clinical trial design (e.g., randomized clinical trials or parallel and cross-over designs), pharmacoeconomic, and the role and new usage of big-data technology in the pharmaceutical and drug development industry. As well, this part will present an introduction to the multiple meanings of global health governance, as well as some perspectives that would be useful to contextualize the analysis of current health issues of international relevance, such as the global pandemic caused by the Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). The impacts of climate change on human health, due to the spread of vector-borne diseases, as well as media coverage of some neglected tropical diseases (NTDs) and risk communication in public health will also be considered. The second part of the course will deal with the current situation of the energy sector, characterized for its vulnerable state, immersed in a transition from fossil fuels to renewable energies. The geopolitics involved in this transition, both regarding its causes and consequences, will be intertwined with the study of the most recent technological trends. The last part of the course regarding the Environment will focus on different elements and perspectives to analyze environmental issues, with applications to what we consider as the main environmental problems of our times.

Descripción de contenidos

Terrorism is not a new phenomenon. It will provide a long-term analytical and substantive foundation, so as to deepen subject matter knowledge, in order, to develop practical policy options for deterring or confronting terrorism in the 21st century. The course will explore the history of terrorism, the evolution of the definition of terrorism, and the nature of both international and domestic terrorist groups, including the effect of modern technology on the activities of such groups. It will further cover the identifications of terrorist groups, and actions by governments to counter terrorism, with specific case studies drawn from the 21st century.

4.5 Actividades y metodologías docentes

ACTIVIDADES Y METODOLOGÍAS DOCENTES

Las actividades y metodologías docentes del título se adaptan a la naturaleza y las dinámicas de cada uno de los cursos, distinguiendo entre aquellos que tengan un enfoque más teórico y lo que sean de una naturaleza más práctica y aplicada. Entre las actividades y metodologías a aplicar se encuentran:

Sesión magistral: este tipo de actividad se centrará en la exposición de los contenidos de la asignatura por parte del profesor con el objetivo de formar a los estudiantes en los conocimientos generales y específicos de la materia, así como de fomentar el análisis y debate crítico sobre los mismos.

Prácticas: este tipo de actividad está encaminada a la formulación, el análisis y la resolución de un problema o ejercicio, relacionado con la temática de la asignatura con el objetivo de situar al estudiante frente a una situación real a la que debe de responder y/o analizar en base al conocimiento y especialización adquirida. Este tipo de prácticas pueden ser tanto orales como escritas.

Seminarios: esta actividad está dirigida a desarrollar un trabajo en profundidad sobre un tema de forma colectiva entre el profesor y los estudiantes. Su objetivo es ampliar los contenidos de sesiones magistrales sobre casos o cuestiones de especial relevancia, pudiendo utilizarse para ello tanto software informático especial, como recursos audiovisuales u otros materiales para favorecer el aprendizaje activo entre los estudiantes.

Tutorías de apoyo académico: este tipo de actividad está destinada a atender y resolver las dudas de los alumnos en sesiones individuales o de pequeños grupos con el profesor. Podrán ser realizadas tanto de forma presencial como online por el cuerpo docente de la titulación.

Tutorías de acompañamiento: esta actividad está destinada a que el docente atienda a los estudiantes de forma individual o en pequeños grupos con el fin de acompañarlos en su trayectoria formativa, más allá de cuestiones específicas vinculadas al temario de las asignaturas. Podrán ser realizadas tanto de forma presencial como online tanto por el cuerpo docente de la titulación, como expertos y colaboradores académicos y profesionales vinculados al programa (ponentes invitados para seminarios especiales).

Tutorías de orientación profesional: este tipo de actividad está destinada a estudiantes que tienen las habilidades y el interés por un campo y una disciplina concreta, así como por contribuir en la producción del conocimiento y/o avance de la profesión en dichas áreas. Podrán ser realizadas tanto de forma presencial como online tanto por el cuerpo docente de la titulación, como expertos y colaboradores académicos y profesionales vinculados al programa (la persona encargada de Career Development Advisory, ponentes invitados para seminarios especiales).

Las actividades y metodologías docentes anteriormente expuestas son presentadas a los estudiantes al inicio de cada asignatura con el objetivo de que el estudiante pueda trazar su propio camino de aprendizaje. Al estar familiarizado con los objetivos del curso y conocerlos de antemano, el estudiante puede comprometerse activamente en la consecución de dichos objetivos y regular su propio proceso de aprendizaje. La autonomía del aprendizaje constituye una cuestión central en el proceso de enseñanza-aprendizaje que se fomenta desde la titulación y tanto las actividades como las metodologías docentes están enfocadas a favorecer la motivación del estudiantado, crear iniciativas innovadoras para aplicar los conocimientos adquiridos en contextos novedosos, desarrollar el pensamiento crítico en los razonamientos, y situarlo en el centro de su proceso de aprendizaje.

SISTEMA DE EVALUACIÓN

Ejercicios prácticos: este metodología de evaluación tiene como objetivo evaluar tanto los conocimientos teóricos como prácticos adquiridos por el estudiante, pudiendo ser realizada tanto de forma oral como escrita, y tanto de manera individual como en grupo. Con ella se permite evaluar el nivel de conocimientos alcanzado por el estudiante así como su capacidad de aplicación de las herramientas metodológicas adecuadas y de trabajo y gestión de grupos. Asimismo, permite evaluar la capacidad de comunicación oral y escrita del estudiante de los resultados y análisis realizados, así como de los conocimientos adquiridos.

Pruebas de desarrollo: las pruebas de desarrollo son pruebas escritas, tanto individuales como en grupo, que pueden incluir tanto ensayos breves, como trabajos finales de investigación, informes y otros análisis escritos en el que el estudiante tenga que demostrar la adquisición de los conocimientos, competencias y habilidades previstas, tanto las de naturaleza teórica, como las de tipo metodológico y comunicativo.

En cuanto a la dirección de los **Trabajos Fin de Máster**, la asignación del profesora seguirá los siguientes criterios:

Adecuación del tema trabajo de investigación del TFM a la especialización del profesor/tutor, pudiendo ser profesor/tutor cualquier docente de la titulación.

En cualquier caso, no se podrá superar el ratio máximo de 7 TFM por profesor/a en el máster.
